



EXAMPLE PRESENTATION – THE STORY OF STEEL PAN

This 90m example presentation is ideal for any size theatre or large hall with a stage, sound and lighting. The band is made up of 3-5 players with a range of instruments including drum kit, bass, guitar pans and tenors. All players are specialists in steel pan playing, making and facilitation and bring their expertise to the presentation.

30-40m	How pans are made, tools explained, about tuners and makers	Artist explains pan making process. Q&A's	10m
40-50m	Participation: Creating calypso rhythms using voice & clapping, accompanying steel band melody	Artist works with audience to create rhythms.	10m
50-60m	Performance 2 – typical calypso	Band play 2 calypso songs with audience clapping to recognised rhythms	10m
60-70m	Have a go at playing steel pans	2-4 members of audience invited to try simple techniques	10m
70-80m	Film: Panorama TnT or UK	Large orchestra example of typical pan performance	10m
80-90m	Questions from Audience	Followed by band playing medley as audience exit	10m
